When Fred Sainnawap began meter reading in 1975 he was 18 years old and there were only 24 meters in his community of Kitchenuhmaykoosib Inninuwug ("KI"). 48 years later at age 66 and now a greatgrandpa, Fred is still going, reading over 400 meters in the growing community.
