Hydro One Remotes continues to grow

This year, Hydro One Remotes expanded its electrical service to three more communities: Poplar Hill First Nation, Keewaywin First Nation and North Spirit Lake. This brings the total northern communities served to 27. This update follows the completion of the First Nations-led, majority-owned Wataynikaneyap Powerline project.

As our business continues to evolve, renovations are underway at the Thunder Bay office. We will be the leading electrical utility and a trusted partner to remote communities in Ontario's north.

Celebrating upgrades in Neskantaga

As energy needs grow in off-grid communities, we're collaborating with local leadership and Indigenous Services Canada to develop Diesel Generating Station (DGS) upgrades.

This July, with Neskantaga First Nation and Matawa Tribal Council, we celebrated the completion of a \$10.7 million, three-year DGS project. Bulk fuel tanks and the DGS were upgraded along with a building expansion to house a new 1,500 kW CAT3516 generator, making this project one of the largest upgrades in Hydro One Remotes history.
